All papers submitted to the HEIC 2011 must not have been published, submitted, or presented at other conferences. Accepted papers will be included in the conference proceedings [Times New Roman, 12, alignment left].

Keywords - Please include 5 key words [Times New Roman, 12, alignment left].

1 SECTION [TIMES NEW ROMAN, 12- POINT, BOLD, UPPER CASE AND ALIGNMENT LEFT]

All the pages of the paper size should be A4 (21 x 29,7cm). The top and bottom margin should be 2,5 cm the left and right margin. All the text must be in one column format and Times New Roman must be used, including figures and tables. double-spaced with 12-point interlining spacing. [Times New Roman, 12 point, normal, alignment justify, upper and lower case]

1.1 Subsection [Times New Roman, 12, bold, alignment left and capitalize the first letter]

The text included in the section or subsection must begin one line after the section or subsection title. Do not use hard tabs, and limit use of hard returns to only one return at the end of a paragraph. Do not number text heads-the template will do that for you.

A. Authors and Affiliations

The HEIC 2011 template has been designed so that author affiliations are not repeated each time for multiple authors of the same affiliation. Please keep your affiliations as succinct as possible (for example, do not differentiate among departments of the same organization).

B. Abbreviations and Acronyms

In order to use abbreviations and acronyms, define them only the first time they are used in the text, even after they have been defined in the abstract. Do not use abbreviations in the title or heads unless it is completely unavoidable.

C. Figures and Tables

Any figures, tables, or graphics used as illustrations in the report should be centred, numbered and accompanied by a legend. (Fig.1. Legend, Table 1. Legend). Each illustration should have a caption below the illustration; table heads should appear above the tables.

Insert figures and tables after they are cited in the text. Use the abbreviation “Fig. 1”, even at the beginning of a sentence.

D. Page numbers

Each page of the paper must have page numbers. Please use the x of y page number format.

2 CITATIONS

The in text citation numbers should be enclosed within brackets. Ex: [1] A list of the works cited should be submitted at the end of the paper. The list of works cited should only include works that are cited in the text. These works should be published or accepted for publication. Personal communications or unpublished works should only be mentioned in the text. Please do not use footnotes or endnotes as a substitute for the citations page.
